Develop your teaching skills

The course is aimed at NQTs, GTs, Teach Firsts and any other training teachers who wish to develop practical strategies for stretching their most able students. It will be an opportunity to improve their classroom practice through structured lesson observation at Queen Elizabeth's.

The course will enhance the CPD profile of delegates through Core standards 7 to 10, 19, 29 and 30.

Course Programme

The session will focus on identifying the key features of lessons, developed for very able students, through structured observation. Delegates will also be invited to bring along a resource or lesson plan they wish to develop.

The training will be delivered on-site at Queen Elizabeth's School in Barnet. Course content will include:

- Group discussions of what enrichment is and experiences of academic enrichment
- Planning for extension in both mixed ability and setted lessons
- Lesson observations in specific departments
